Award for students in 'Service Leadership Programs' (SLP)--K-Kids, Builders, Key and Circle K Clubs

**Nominate a deserving student leader
in your Division's K-Kids, Builders, Key or
Circle K Clubs for the
Hayden Leadership Medallion!**



Selection Criteria

- ✓ The student must be a current student member in good standing of a K-Kids, Builders, Key or Circle K Club, which is sponsored by an adult Kiwanis Club
- ✓ **The student is nominated only by the SLP School Advisor and not by a parent**
- ✓ **Only one (1) nomination** will be accepted **per school per year**, and a student can only receive the **Hayden Medallion one time**
- ✓ To be nominated, the student has demonstrated outstanding **Service Leadership** through the school's SLP in which he/she is a member

Nomination Process

- ✓ The SLP School Advisor completes the NOMINATION (using form next page) and sends for approval to the President of the Kiwanis Club that sponsors this SLP Club
- ✓ The President of the Kiwanis Club that sponsors this SLP Club approves the nomination and sends it to the Division LT Governor for approval

Final Approval Before Division Rally

- ✓ The Division LT Governor emails the approved nomination form to Dr. Lucy Hayden, GA District coordinator, for this award program. (lucillechayden@gmail.com)
- ✓ Once she approves the nomination, Dr Hayden will notify the Governor and the LT Governor, so that the Medallion can be presented the Division's Rally

What Each LT Governor Does

✓ **In October or November:**

- **Notify** the President and Secretary of each Kiwanis Club in your Division about the **Hayden SLP Medallion and explain why it is important for students to receive this recognition at the Division Rally.**
- Ask the Club President/Secretary to inform each SLP (K Kids, Builders Club, Key Club and Circle K that they sponsor) about the award and how to nominate a deserving student
- There is no cost to your Division for these awards. They have been purchased and are distributed through donations to the GA Kiwanis District Foundation
- **Every SLP sponsored in your Division** should be encouraged and assisted to identify a deserving student for this award!

- ✓ Prepare a *Division Rally Timeline* and include the date and procedures for nominating a student

- Notify clubs of the deadline for submitting a nomination for the Hayden Medallion to you
- Before sending the nomination to Lucy Hayden, GA District coordinator, check for completeness.

✓ **No later than 2 weeks before your Governor's**

Rally: Email each approved nomination form to Dr. Lucy Hayden, GA District coordinator.

- Once she approves the nomination, she will notify the Governor and you—she will email a final list of the names of those students to be awarded a Hayden Medallion. The Governor will bring the required number of Medallions to your Rally.
- **IMPORTANT!** Coordinate with the Governor about remarks (for presenting the Medallions) that will be made at the Rally. Be Prepared!
