### The Hayden Student Leadership (SLP) Medallion 2023-2024

Award for student leaders in GA's 'Service Leadership Programs' (SLP)--K-Kids, Builders, Key Clubs and Circle K

#### What the LT. Governor Does

**Notify** the President and Secretary of each Kiwanis Club in your Division about

- the **Hayden SLP Medallion** and explain why it is important for students to receive this recognition at the Division Rally
- Ask that they inform each SLP (K Kids, Builders Club, Key Club and Circle K that they sponsor) about the award and
- Explain how to nominate a deserving student and the deadline for submitting nominations to you

**Every SLP sponsored in your Division** should be encouraged and assisted to identify a deserving student for this award!

There is no cost to your Division for these awards. They have been purchased and are distributed through donations to the GA Kiwanis District Foundation

#### **At least 1 month before your Governor's Rally:**

- Check that you have received all completed Hayden SLP Medallion nominations
- Emailed them to Lucy Hayden GA District Coordinator ([lucillechayden@gmail.com](mailto:lucillechayden@gmail.com))

**IMPORTANT!** It's your responsibility to coordinate with the Governor on 'when' and 'how' these Medallions will be presented at your Rally  
The Governor will bring the required number of Medallions to your Rally

#### **About 2 weeks before your Governor's Rally:**

- Once Dr. Hayden approves your Division's nominations, she will notify you and the Governor (by email) with a final list of those approved to be awarded the Medallion

#### What School SLPs & Kiwanis Clubs Do

##### How to Nominate an SLP Student Leader

##### The SLP School Advisor:

- Completes the nomination form based on the **Selection Criteria** (found on the next page)
- Sends the nomination form for signature to the President of the Kiwanis Club that sponsors this SLP Club

The President of the sponsoring Kiwanis Club

- Sends the nomination to the Division LT Governor for signature (**must be done before the Division Rally**)

##### **Hayden SLP Medallion Selection Criteria**

*Nominate a deserving student leader in your **K-Kids, Builders, Key or Circle K Club** for the **Hayden SLP Student Leadership Medallion***

- The nominee must be a current student member in good standing of a K-Kids, Builders, Key or Circle K Club, which is sponsored by an adult Kiwanis Club
- **The student is nominated only by the SLP School Advisor and not by a parent**
- **Only one (1) nomination** will be accepted **per school per year**
- A student can only receive the **Hayden Medallion** one time
- To be nominated, the student has demonstrated outstanding **Service Leadership in three (3) areas** through the school's SLP in which he/she is a member
