

Georgia District of Kiwanis General Session

AUGUST 18, 2018 Jekyll Conference Center, Jekyll Island, GA

Governor Juanita Edwards rang the bell and called the general session of the 99th annual convention of the Georgia District to order at 8:15 A.M.

The Girl Scout Troop 30024 presented colors and Debbie Brilling, Governor Elect led the Pledge.

Michael A. Smith, Spiritual Aims Chair gave the invocation.

Andy Pipkin, Vice Governor, introduced guest.

Charles "Chuck" Gugliuzza, International Trustee, from the Florida District addressed the session.

Marisa Hoenig, 2018-19 CKI Governor addressed the session. She is a senior at Georgia Tech. Circle K International has 13,000 members – small but mighty. They provide more service hours per member than any SLP.

Charlie Jerrell, Georgia District Kiwanis Foundation President addressed the session. He nominated Kathy Harrell and Barry Gardner to the board of the foundation. Nominations were approved by acclimation.

Karen Losin provided the delegate count: present: 146 delegates and 43 at-large delegates for a total of 189 to vote.

The floor was opened for nominations for Governor Elect. Keithen Tucker, Lt. Governor of Division 18 from the Eatonton Club placed Andy Pipkin in nomination. A second was made by Bryon Mullican, Past Lt. Governor from the Brooklet Club. Andy was elected by acclimation.

The floor was opened for nominations for Vice Governor. Richard Dixon, Past Governor and from the Carrollton Club placed George Elkins in nomination. A second was made by Janine Hunter with the

Baxley Club. George was elected by acclimation. George provided a speech of why he is seeking the office of Vice Governor.
